You do not need an account to complete the activities.</p>	<p>Día 2</p>  <p>Choose a Spanish-speaking country and find 10 fascinating facts about it. You could think about unusual traditions, foods or famous people. For a greater challenge, write your facts in Spanish.</p>	<p>Día 3</p>  <p>Click on https://quizlet.com/4wms0b?x=1jqt&i=aaxsn and study this Quizlet set to develop your sophisticated structures.</p>	<p>Día 4</p>  <p>Click on https://www.rtve.es/noticias/ and then click on Telediario en 4 to watch four minute version of the news. Alternatively, you can watch the entire news show which lasts 50 minutes. (Don't worry – they talk very fast. See if you can pick out the key words or topics of the news items)</p>
<p>Día 5</p>  <p>Click on https://conjuguemos.com/activities/spanish/verb/1 and practise your verb conjugation. You can start with the present tense or dive in with something more complicated. Create your own play list of Spanish songs.</p>	<p>Día 16</p>  <p>Research a weird and wonderful festival in Spain or a Spanish-speaking country. Maybe you'll choose the baby jumping festival, the one where they used to throw the goat from a tower or the more normal tomato battle. You could describe your chosen festival to a friend or family member.</p>
<p>Día 17</p>  <p>Click on https://quizlet.com/_8cpsfq?x=1qqt&i=aaxsn to practise your higher level GCSE vocabulary. This is a massive set so don't try to do it all at once. Consider starring 20 words and studying those first. You can always go back to them and study new ones next time.</p>	<p>Día 18</p>  <p>Click on https://www.rtve.es/noticias/ and then click on Telediario en 4 to watch four minute version of the news. Alternatively you can watch the entire news show which lasts 50 minutes.</p>	<p>Día 19</p>  <p>Click on https://conjugemos.com/activities/spanish/verb/1 and practise your verb conjugation. If you did the present tense last time, try something more challenging. Choose practice or games.</p>	<p>Día 20</p>  <p>Click on https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCAL4AMMMXKxHDu3FqZV6CbQ and watch some of the easy Spanish videos. Use the subtitles to help you to understand new words and don't forget to write down anything you learn.</p>

Rosalia is extremely popular in Spain at the moment as she mixes traditional Flamenco music with modern pop. Her songs are quite subversive – you might be able to spot some Spanish traditions which she is mocking in the video.</p>	<p>Día 23</p>  <p>Research a controversial topic relating to Spain or a Spanish speaking country. It could be whether Catalonia should be allowed to become independent, whether bull fighting should be banned, whether Barca or Real Madrid are better or any other topic which interests you. Try to make notes on both sides of the argument in either Spanish or English.</p>	<p>Día 24</p>  <p>Create a Memrise account – your name or something that is very recognisable as you. You should aim to achieve 100,000 points by the first lesson! You could start by joining the A-level group. Log into Memrise using your new log in and then click on: https://www.memrise.com/group/352141/ to join the group to join the group and start studying some of the sets attached to the group.</p>
