Level 2 C&G/CTEC Diplomas

This is a one-year course. Students will apply to restart Year 12 on Pathways 2-4 once their Level 2 course is completed

You will resit GCSE Maths AND/OR English Language, as required



BTEC/CTEC/DIPLOMA Courses




- Coursework based subjects such as BTEC or CTECs, and Diplomas




