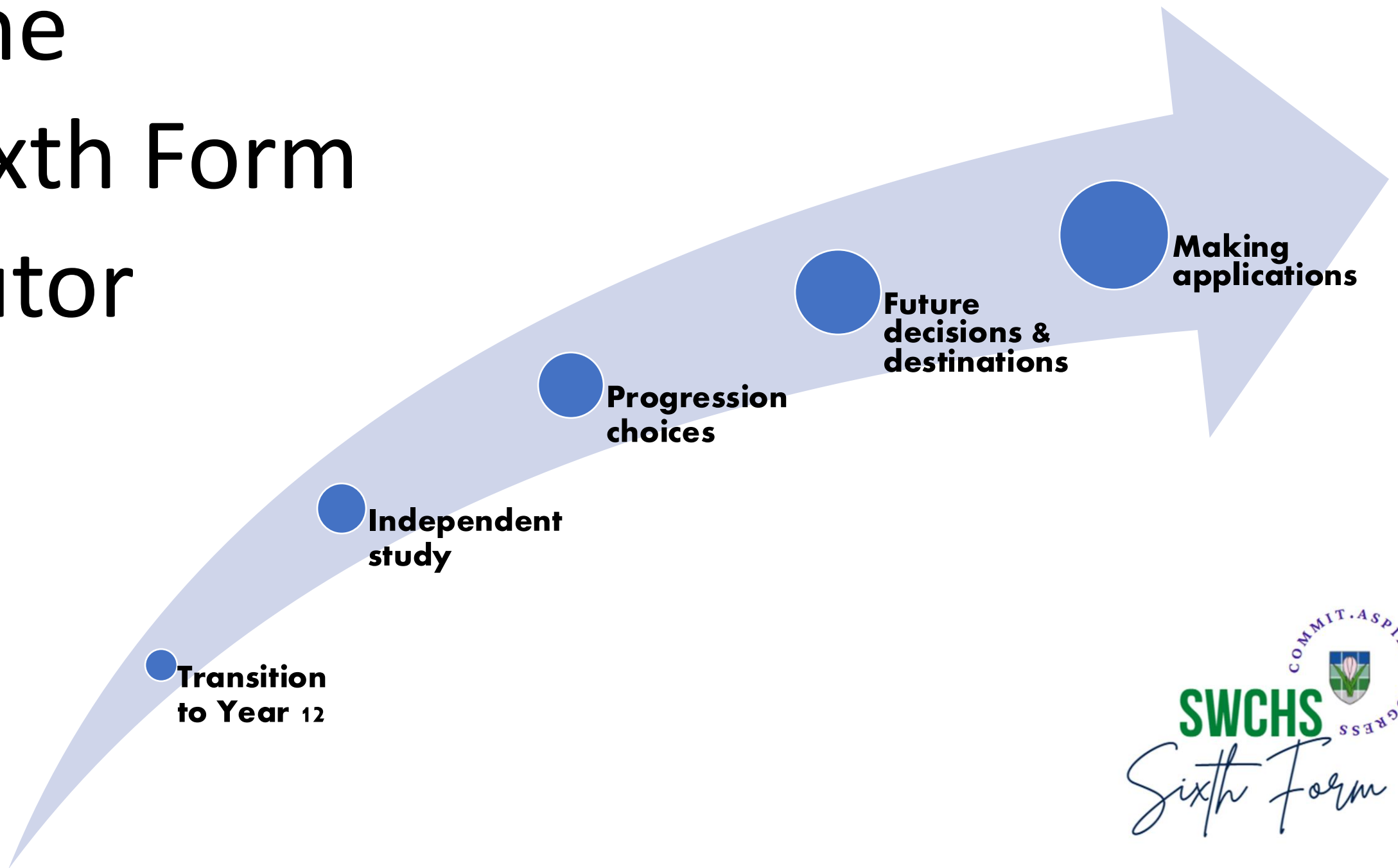

This could mean arriving late or leaving early, or going out for lunch (depending on their timetable).



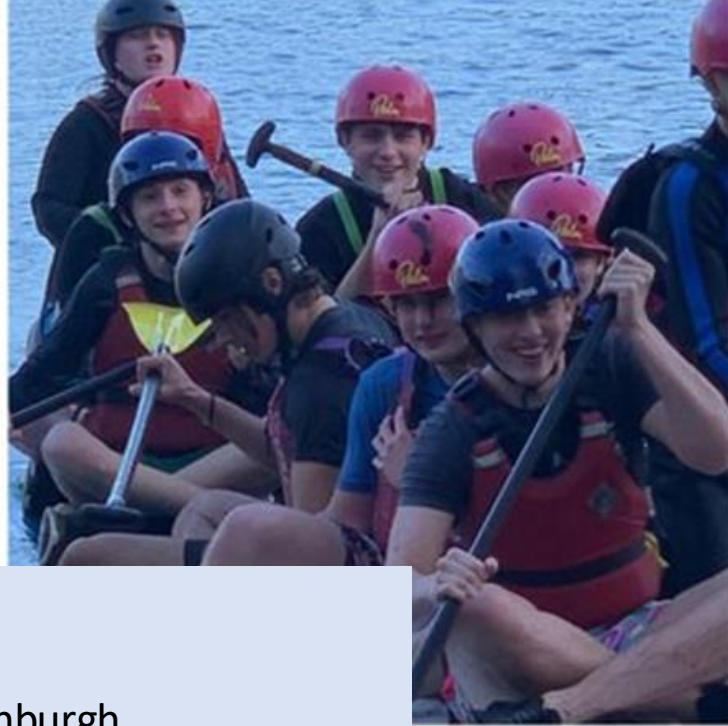
