#### **Task**

- 1) Study Stage 29 *Roma* of CLC Book 4, paying particular attention to the model sentences at the start of the stage and the grammar note on p8 which recaps the passive voice. Then translate on alternate lines 'nox I and II' on p4 and p5. It would be good to do in last few weeks of the holiday to refresh your translation skills. Please do independently: you can access a dictionary by clicking on 'Resources' in top righthand corner. Bring this to your first Latin lesson in September.

    - Make a mind map for each of the following characters with details about who they are and their key actions in Book 1 and 4: Dido and Aeneas

#### **How will this work be used in lessons?**

- 1) Stage 29 will help you freshen up your translation skills after a long break and be good revision before we tackle the study of all passive forms in September.
- 2) Book 4 of the Aeneid is one of the Latin literature set texts which you will study for A Level. You need knowledge of Book 1 lines 613-end and the whole of Book 4 in English. This task will give you a good overview ahead of studying the Latin in Y12.

#### **How long will this task take?**

5 hours across the two tasks (do not spend more than 2 hours on Task 1).
