# From the Associate Headteacher

Dear Parents/Carers,

It seems a long time ago now, but I would just like to take a moment to reflect on the two extremely happy results days that we had in August. It was so lovely to be in school on those days and to see our students celebrate the outcome of their hard work. Our A Level results were exceptionally strong, even better than those of 2018, despite this being one of the biggest cohorts we have ever had in Year 13. 40% of entries were graded A or A\* and 90% were graded A\* - C. These results also indicated that this cohort had made outstanding progress and they confirm, yet again, that we have one of the best Sixth Forms in the country. Year 11 then achieved our best ever set of GCSE results. Their results showed our attainment to be the highest of all the non-selective schools in the county, and the progress of our students was also outstanding. Last year's Year 11 can be justifiably proud of their achievements and we are delighted to welcome so many of them back to Year 12.

We are very lucky to have such a fantastic team of teachers here at County High and I am delighted with the appointments we have made for 2019 – 2020. We are fully staffed with subject specialists of the highest quality and our new staff are introduced to you below.

We are always looking for ways in which we can enrich your child's time with us and provide the opportunities that make for a truly outstanding education and you can read about some of the things Year 7 have been up to in this newsletter.
