Task

- 1. Either read the Overview Article on the website or listen to the podcast linked below: https://www.historyextra.com/period/medieval/henry-vi-terrible-king/
- 2. Make notes on the following question: To what extent was Henry VI responsible for the Wars of the Roses?

You need to bring these notes with you to your first History lesson in September.

To help you do this....

- a) note down ALL arguments and examples/evidence she provides that say Henry was the main cause of the problems
- b) note down OTHER explanations that she suggests, along with examples that she might use.
- c) THINK what parts of the Wars of the Roses does Henry VI bear most responsibility for?
- 3. EITHER read Mortimer's Time Traveller's Guide to Medieval England <u>OR</u> read ONE of the following historical novels on the Wars of the Roses

Conn Iggulden, Stormbird Trilogy (Covers the whole of the period)

Philippa Gregory The White Queen (Focuses on Edward IV)

How will this work be used in lessons?

We will start the course discussing the rule of Henry VI and consider how far he can be held responsible for the developing conflict.
