In hall assessments: between Thursday 13th and Thursday 20th June, year 10 students will sit their end of year assessments in English, Science and Maths in Saffron Hall. This helps students to get used to going into Saffron Hall to do assessments, so that they are more used to it when it comes to the mocks in Y11 (and the exams at the end of year 11). They provide an opportunity for students to consolidate their learning at the end of the year, develop effective revision strategies and get used to the protocols in the hall. More information about these will be issued in the summer term by Mr Norman and students will be given guidance by relevant subjects about what will be covered in these assessments and how to prepare for them.

Sports Day: this will take place on **Wednesday 10th July**. More information will be provided nearer the time by the PE department.

School photos: year 10 will have individual and cohort photos on **Tuesday 16**th **July**. Mrs Chasey will be organising these.

Camping: Mr Blayney is taking the whole year group camping. Students on the S side of the year group will leave school on Thursday 18th July, camp that night and return to school on Friday 19th July. Students on the W side of the year group will leave school on Monday 22nd July, camp that night and return to school on Tuesday 23rd July. Mr Blayney will be providing more information about this later this term.

Work Experience: each student will undertake two days of work experience in July. Work experience will be on the days that the other side of the year group are camping. Those students on the W side of the year group will do work experience on Thursday 18th and Friday 19th July.
